WFP TO SPEAK WITH ITS CONTRACTORS AND CONSULT INDIGENOUS PARTNERS - BARGAINING TO RESUME JULY 25TH

The Union and the Company met again last week for two days (June 27th and 28th) as the parties continued to work through important union security and legal issues that have slowed down the bargaining process.

WFP advised us earlier this week that they want to take the next two weeks to speak with their contractors and consult Indigenous partners on related matters. The parties intend to get back together on July 25th and August 1st to resume bargaining.

The Union will set a time to consult with our Camp and Plant Chairs prior to the 25th.

Both parties remain hopeful that we will be able to work through these issues and move the process forward.
