### **TENTATIVE AGREEMENT REACHED WITH WFP**

Dear Members,

On Thursday November 28, 2024, at 5:45 pm, your United Steelworkers Local 1-1937 Bargaining Committee reached a tentative agreement with Western Forest Products Inc.

Bargaining between the parties began on April 5<sup>th</sup> this year.

We are very happy to have finally reached a tentative agreement with the Company. The agreement we believe addresses many of the issues raised by our members and passed at the Local Unions wage and contract conference in February of this year. We recognize the hard work and dedication demonstrated by both parties, throughout the bargaining process to reach this tentative agreement.

We believe the tentative agreement we have reached is something our members will strongly support. Your bargaining team is recommending acceptance. Details will follow over the coming days.

Following a release of the tentative agreement details the Union will be organizing area meetings to present the agreement followed by ratification voting.
